Over more than 20 years, nearly 30,000 students have completed the challenge, earning the title of Champion Reader and recognition from former Mayor Brown at a special VIP ceremony. Champion Readers also qualify for prize drawings, including laptops, Kindles, bicycles, and academic supplies.

Our funding to Community Connections in Findley Lake, New York, was awarded to address health disparities in rural Chautauqua County. Through community health advocate and home companion programs, we support nurses and aides working with residents in their homes.
